Life on Earth

Understanding life on Earth is one of the most complicated things. I will try to explain in an easy way how I see it. In the course of time, many people asked me many questions. I don't know how we ended up in the illusion; it could be that God wanted us to learn that we carry His great power, and we need to discover it or maybe God was playing. The answer is that it doesn't matter. What matters is what we need to do to regain the Kingdom of God.

The Kingdom of God is within us, and nowhere else. It is a state of being, and one needs to find the strength to discover the truth. Jesus was the greatest example on Earth to prove that there is more than meets the eye.

Life on Earth as we see it now looks real. Try to step aside and ask yourself "is it possible that there is another reality?" Those who went ahead discovered that there is another reality, and if you look closely inside yourself and allow yourself to feel, you will discover that it is possible.

But the fact is that we are here on Earth and most of us are stuck in **this** reality with all these differences. As I wrote in the Isaia Scripture:

It is a learning process for humanity to look past the differences on Earth (the illusion) and to accept each other as true brothers and sisters, so that a unity is formed in which people are responsible for each other and life on Earth. This is the way to Enlightenment, the way of the Messiah, the way to deep peace on Earth.

How do we cope with all those differences? To do that, we need to understand them.

Life on Earth is a learning school for us and cannot be compared to what we are taught in 'normal' schools. Everything we experience on Earth belongs to the learning process. I do mean everything; nothing is left out. Your learning process is solely between you and God. In discovering the truth we are put to a test, and some of us are tested in horrendous ways. By acknowledging the fact that everything is a learning process we take control again. By casting blame we lose control of our own life, and we will suffer. Try it in your life and see what it does for you.

We are born in a certain family that reflects the best learning experience in our growth at that moment. It doesn't matter if your parents love you, hate you or put you up for adoption. It is still your learning process. For those believing in reincarnation and karma it is easier to understand. As

long as we are living in the illusion, we are confronted with karma, i.e. cause and effect. In our daily life we are experiencing karma as well, some immediately and some later or in another life.

By taking the responsibilities of our own lessons, we can solve bad karma and learn the power of forgiveness and compassion. Karma is solved when we are grateful for our lessons, even if we don't see an immediate result.

Furthermore, we are born into a certain environment, also for our lessons. We are born in a certain country, also for our lessons. When we move to another country, that is also for our lessons. Every step we take, every door we walk through is part of our learning process. In this case every country carries its own learning process. It is up to us to rise above these differences.

The neighbours' grass might seem greener, however, it is an illusion. By taking responsibility for our own life and stand your ground, we learn what we need to learn and discover a power that is beyond our belief. We don't know our neighbours' learning process, but we can make something of our own life.

Acknowledging that you are the soul and not the body will help you to look beyond the illusion. It is in this physical body, though, where we need to embody our being. By inhaling yourself, you become more of what you truly are; a soul living in a physical body on Earth.

When we learn to step out of the concept of duality we discover that we are truly brothers and sisters, we go beyond our illusionary belief. Everything we see on Earth that touches our heart is an opening to another dimension, a dimension of togetherness and oneness. It is an opening to the flow of compassion and love. By helping each other we become the helping hand of God (being of service to the creation). God's love is everlasting, and the greatest power there is. It is not God that lets us suffer on Earth, it is our own thoughts and belief.
